REVIEW & INVESTIGATION

The Title IX Coordinator will meet with the reporting party to discuss reporting options. Interim measures and referrals to support services will be offered.

The Title IX Coordinator along with the student will determine if the University needs to conduct a Title IX investigation.

RESOLUTION

At the conclusion of the investigation, the Title IX Coordinator will make a finding of fact. The finding of fact will be determined using the preponderance of evidence standard.

A no-contact directive may be issued in writing to persons involved in the investigation.

Sanctions may be imposed.

Either party may appeal the decision if new evidence becomes available.

This flowchart addresses violations of the Sexual Misconduct Policy. Sexual Misconduct refers to dating violence, domestic assault, domestic violence, rape, sexual assault, sexual harassment and stalking.
